



Tennis Coaching 2019 Programs & Fees

HoneyBee Kidz Tennis programs are coordinated by Tennis Australia Club Professional and ATPCA Level 2 Advanced Pro coach, Barbara Honey-Martin. We are also an ANZ Hot Shots provider and a registered provider for the NSW Government's Active Kids Program. An emphasis on fun, practice and increased difficulty will see young players develop and improve tennis strokes and game skills by progressing at a level that suits their personal abilities. Please note that ages specified with the different groups are indicated as a general guide only – classes are graded on ability and not specifically on age. Merit cards are awarded weekly to one deserving student in each group with an incentive to collect the complete set of six cards. .

Introductory Coaching Program for children 4-8 years offers young children a fun, positive and exciting introduction to the game of tennis. Specialised teaching aids are used including smaller racquets, low compression tennis balls, mini nets and smaller courts. Innovative teaching methods and fun games are introduced to develop and improve coordination, movement, tactics and the basics of the main tennis strokes. Beginners are very welcome.

Development Coaching Program for children 8+ years offers exciting challenges to develop and improve a child's tennis abilities. New skills and more intensive drills and games are introduced as students progress. Students will gain self confidence as they develop their game skills and learn to face the challenges and excitement of competition. It is recommended that this stage also participates in our Saturday ANZ Hot Shots Match Play.

Development Squad Training is available to those demonstrating a desire to really develop and be further involved with their tennis. Squad Training is in addition to our regular coaching programs and by no means replaces lessons. Squad Training is by invitation only and participants must have achieved a required level of play to receive an invitation.

Weekly Coaching Lessons are offered after school during all four NSW school terms. Each term's program usually runs for 8 weeks. HoneyBee Kidz Tennis group lessons are held at Thurgoona Tennis Centre at Thurgoona Country Club Resort. Private lessons also available by arrangement. Places are limited – please book early to avoid disappointment via the online Registration Form.

Proposed days and fees for 8 week term

Group and private lessons are offered Monday to Thursday after school and Saturday mornings, depending on demand. Please ensure to provide your preferred day and time availability when completing the online Registration Form. We try our best to allocate your first class preference, however, group lessons will only run with a minimum of 4 students of similar age/ability. Private lessons can also be arranged for 1-3 students with cost per student as detailed below. Group lesson sessions are confirmed a couple of days prior to start of term. Times for private lessons will be negotiated. A minimum deposit of \$20 will secure your child's place in a group lesson. Please note: We may occasionally run a shorter term, particularly in the winter months, where fees will be reduced pro-rata.

*Ages specified are an indication only – classes are graded on ability, not specifically on age. All groups have maximum of 6 students per coach except Red group Stage 1 which has maximum of 4 students per coach. Adult coaching is available when time allows by appointment only.

Saturday Morning ANZ Hot Shots Match Play is designed to give children approx. 7-14 years, the opportunity to transition from learning the game to playing matches in a fun team environment. We use Red Courts (approx. 1/2 court with mini-net) and Orange Courts (approx. 2/3 court with standard net), and transition to Green Courts (full standard court without tramlines) and Yellow Courts (standard full-size court) as appropriate. Match Play runs Saturday mornings from 9:30–11:30 am during NSW school terms. Cost is \$10 per Junior Tennis Club member per week OR \$13 for non-members. Tennis Membership with TCCR

All players participating in HoneyBee Kidz Tennis programs are required to be Tennis Members with Thurgoona Country Club Resort – please complete the downloadable TCCR Membership form and join at the Club's Reception. Annual tennis membership fees are currently: Children \$20, Adults \$50. A Tennis membership allows FREE court hire on available courts in daylight hours.
